

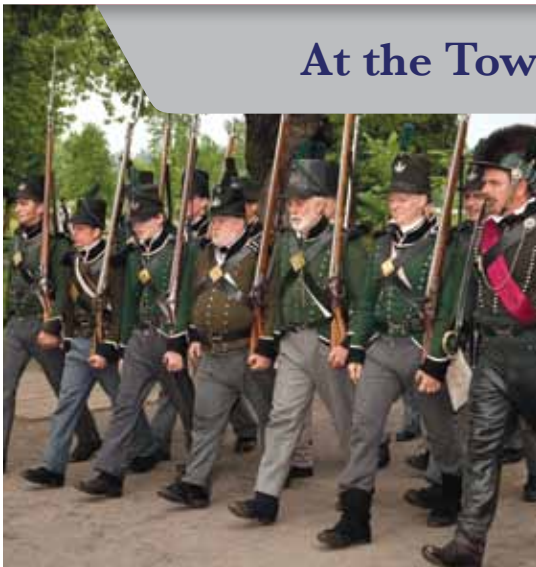
War of 1812
